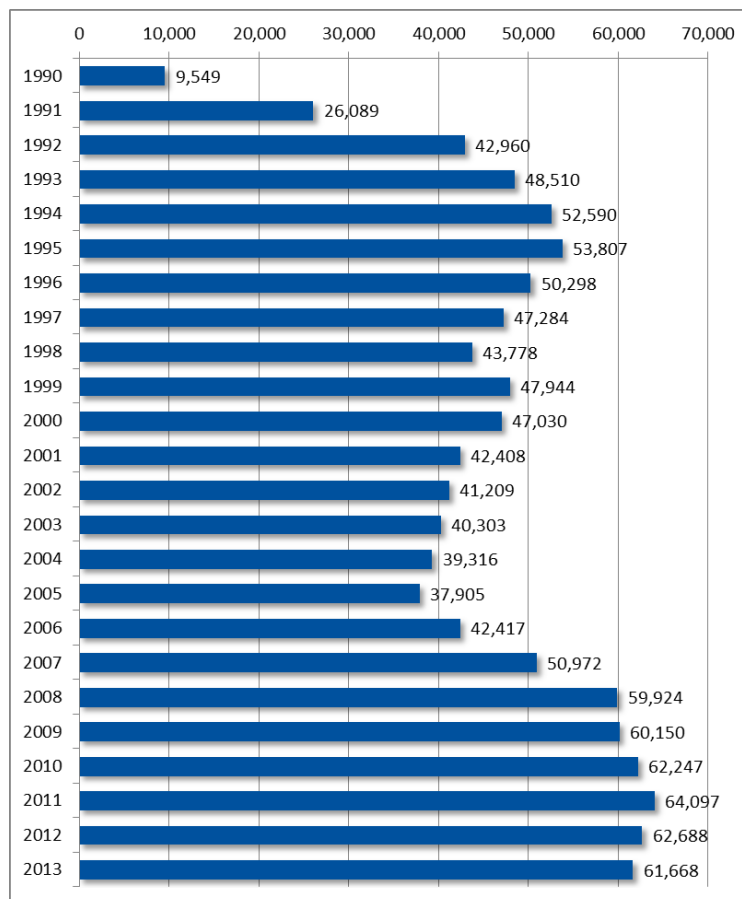


Traffic statistics

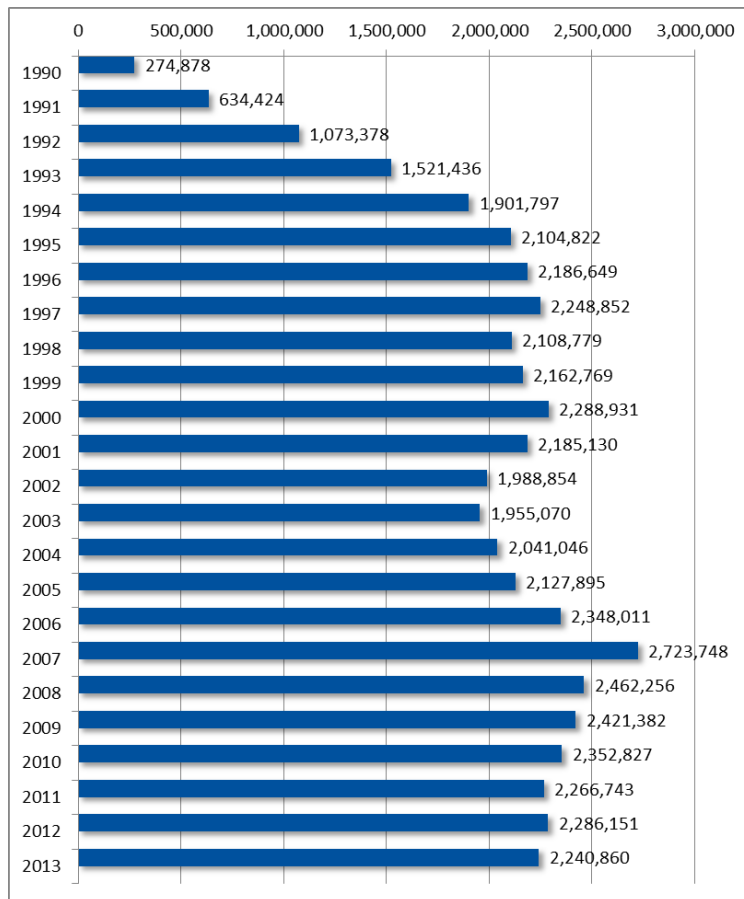
Since the German reunification, Leipzig/Halle Airport has experienced a fast-paced development in traffic. While in 1990 there were only just under 275,000 passengers, there were more than a million passengers by 1992. This number doubled by 1995. This positive trend continued during the following years.

In 2012, 2,286,151 passengers passed through Leipzig/Halle Airport, an increase of 0.9 percent over 2011. Freight volumes at Leipzig/Halle Airport set a new record for the eighth time in succession. The airport handled 863,665 tonnes during the whole of 2012, which represents a growth rate of 13.6 percent. The airport is therefore continuing to enhance its position as Germany's second-largest freight hub and is also consolidating its status as one of the most important air cargo transshipment points in Europe.

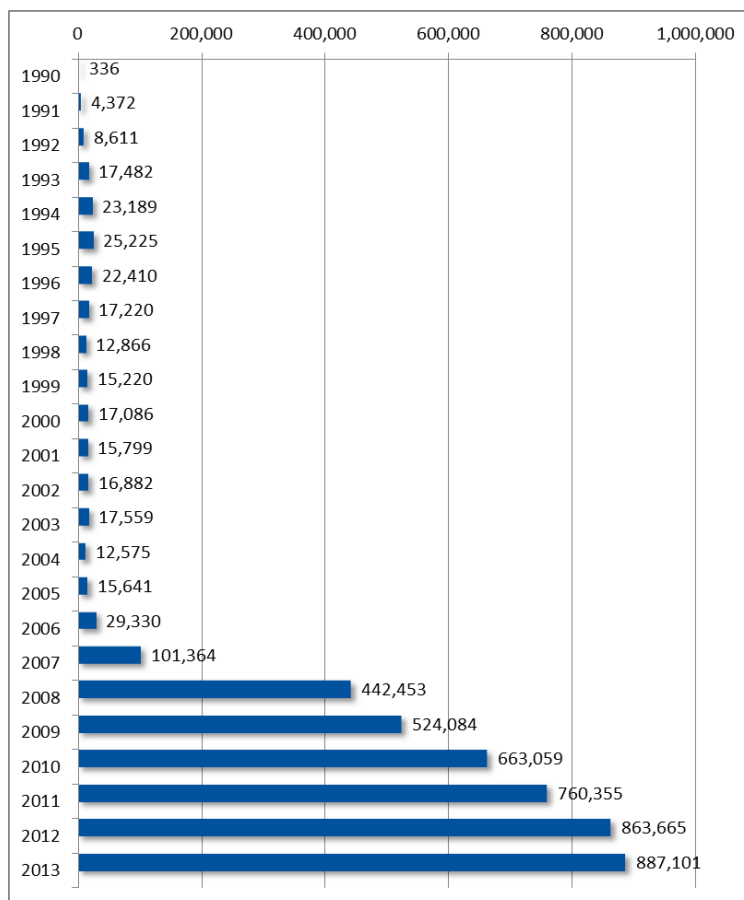
Development in overview
